ATTENDANCE AMO 2.5

Our LCAP goal regarding attendance (AMO 2.5) is to maintain a minimum attendance of 94% for both the middle school and high school. Let's celebrate our first month's success meeting that goal!

ACHIEVEMENT AMO 2.1 & 2.2, English and Math Proficiency

The SWAG lab is off to solid start, as is our lunch tutorial, and new incomplete policies. Teachers are using the lab to be able to re-teach students in their classes who have not yet achieved mastery while allowing students who have shown mastery an opportunity to continue to advance. ARA on Friday's has a new model and has already been a source of success for clearing incomplete grades and getting caught up on Empowers.

AMO 2.3, English Learners

Our 5th period EL classes are off to a great start with an average daily attendance of 85% to this point. Small group instruction is already yielding successes that we hope will translate into meeting our goal of 2% of our students being reclassified or advancing at least one level over our last baselines in 2017-18.

AMO 3.2, Increase Parent Attendance to HSHMC events
Over 500 families and their students have already attended our first 3 events of the year. We are on already pace to exceed our target for this year of 40% or more of our families attending school based events.

AMO 3.3 & 3.5, Students feeling valued and welcomed
